- Hand harvested grapes
- Reduced yield (75 hl/ha)
- Sustainable production
- Bottle Fermented (Traditional method)
- 30 months on the lees
- Disgorged in July 2017
- 1,250 cases made

### **Terroir**

The grapes for this sparkling wine originate from the Teufelspfad ("devil's path") vineyard with limestone and lime marl soil types.



Fine notes of ripe peaches on the nose with hints of herbs, juniper and citrus. Intense and powerful palate with a salty minerality.

## Winemaker's Note:

- Hand harvested grapes
- Late harvest in November
- Low yield (28 hl/ha = 2 vine = 1 bottle)
- 10 hrs maceration
- 3 months spontaneous fermentation
- 3 months on the lees
- 3 months ageing in steel tank and oak barrels
- Sustainable production
- 170 cases made

### **Terroir**

"Grand Cru" class Riesling from the top site "Teufelspfad" with a very high limestone content, ideal for expressive wines with high minerality, density and complexity.



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
